Introduction

<u>June 18</u>

As I put down my checkbook in frustration, I looked upward and sarcastically said to the Lord, "If you're not going to provide enough money for rent next month I may as well put all my stuff in storage, pack up my car, and travel across the U.S. catching up with people I haven't seen in a while." After a few seconds of silence, I sighed deeply, put my checkbook away, and went on with my day.

The following week during a visit with friends, I shared what I said to the Lord. Then suddenly, without even a glimmer of thought, out of my mouth came the words, "It would certainly be a G-d¹ Adventure where I can be His hands and feet for people He places in my path, and I can offer to give my Celebrate Recovery Testimony in CR locations across the USA along my journey."

The moment I finished that sentence I knew my flippant comment a week earlier had suddenly become a divine invitation to deepen my faith and my intimacy with the Lord by going on a journey similar to Abraham: "By faith, Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going" (Hebrews 11:8 / ESV).

In my heart I suspected the Lord prompted that unintended comment, but in reality it made no sense so I wrestled with it for a few days. After all, I wasn't excited about giving up the room I was renting to essentially live out of my car and "couch surf" for an unspecified amount of time until the Lord turned around my financial situation.

Not to mention, how would I pay the bills which have to be paid no matter what my life looks like at any given moment? I generate some income as a contractor for a consultant I work with a few hours a month, but it's certainly not enough to cover all my expenses. Realistically, it would be far more logical to put my company on hold and get a part-time job until things turned around.

The G-d Adventure invitation seemed like a crazy idea in my situation.....and yet the more I prayed over the next few days, the more I continually sensed the Lord telling me that this "crazy" adventure would lay the foundation for all the blessings He planned on giving me in the next season of my life.

I would like to say when I sensed what He wanted that I automatically responded, "Yes, Lord, your will be done!" -- but I didn't. Instead I said, "Really? Are you sure? Can I have some confirmation before I totally uproot my life again for the 4th time in two years?"

Despite that uncertainty, the Lord knows my heart's desire is to be totally surrendered to Him. Within a week He lovingly provided three confirmations (all in one day) from various newsletters, devotions, and a women's conference I watched online. The first confirmation made me laugh out loud: In Todd White's newsletter, the first sentence was: "...Summertime is a perfect time to go on <u>God adventures</u> with your family and friends...." (underline is my emphasis).

How much more direct does the Lord have to be with me? Much more, it seems, because even after I received those three confirmations, I still resisted and asked for one more (remember Gideon, anyone??). I'm sure the Lord was humorously smiling at my need for more certainty. He honored me yet again by providing another newsletter

confirmation from a different organization which stated: "Take time and days, even seasons, to have days off and to go on a sabbatical trip with the Lord."

It was pointless to avoid the truth any longer. I knew the Lord was giving me a choice to go on the Adventure with Him rather than try to fix my financial situation my way. The Lord often used the financial area of my life to get my attention for any one of the following reasons: a) to re-direct me, b) to heal something inside of me, or c) to stop me long enough to deal with something before I can advance to whatever he has for me next. Whatever His reason, it's always to set me up for something better.

Over the last year I had gone through an extensive healing process (that's how I got into Celebrate Recovery² / CR) and also worked through several things which needed to be dealt with. Therefore, it seems this trip is a re-direct to develop additional skills and spiritual gifts before the Lord reveals whatever He has planned for the next season of my life. His way is always much better than my way, so I let my landlord know what I was up to and began to prepare to head out in a few weeks.

Since the Lord personally invited me on this Adventure with Him, I am excited about all the amazing things that are bound to happen and I am also somewhat apprehensive about the uncertainty of it all. Objectively I know the Lord is Jehovah Jireh, my Provider, and He will go before me to prepare my way (Deuteronomy 31:8). Therefore, I am choosing faith and will partner with the spirit of joy as I prepare to leave, commanding anxiety, worry and fear to BE GONE, in the name of Yeshua (Jesus' Hebrew name).

As I reflect on that providential day in June, I am still in awe of everything that has occurred over the past seven months. I left on the Adventure as a woman on fire for the Lord, and returned with more intensity, an even deeper level of faith, and a fuller assurance that the Lord loves to show up and show off when we honor Him through our obedience.

This book is a combination of the blog entries I shared throughout my Adventure along with deeper dives into topics the Lord laid on my heart as I was writing the book. Some of the blog entries are videos, and a link has been provided in the book for you to view them.

My suggestion is to not skip ahead as you read through the book or watch all the videos at once. The faith journey and the lessons I learned during the Adventure happened in the order the Lord arranged on purpose. Like any great story, I encourage you to read this book as it occurred and watch how the Lord speaks to you from chapter to chapter.

Before you begin, take a moment to ask the Lord to highlight the information that is important for your life right now because He knows what you need to know as you move into the next season of your life.

I had no idea when I left Atlanta that my "Crazy" Adventure would truly become a blessing in disguise!

May this book be a blessing to you as well, and may my story be a catalyst for you to take the first step towards your own Adventure with the Lord!

Chapter 2 - Jehovah Jireh Reigns

<u>July 10</u>

It's been just over a week since I made the decision to accept the Lord's invitation to go on an Adventure with Him.

Since then it's been a whirlwind of activity arranging to store my motorcycle with a friend, coordinating mail and other things with my Dad, alerting friends and family of estimated timelines for when I may be in their area, and mentally reviewing all of my stuff to determine what I need to pack in my car and what I can live without.

As I was doing all this planning, it suddenly occurred to me that my 18-year-old car would need to be serviced to make sure it was safe to travel across the country for an unspecified amount of time. With limited financial resources, I knew it was going to be interesting to cover that cost along with the other bills coming due in the next two weeks. But I also knew the Lord invited me on this trip, which meant I could trust He was going before me to prepare whatever I needed (Ps 139:5). Yesterday those provisions began.

I went online to see what auto service centers were in the area and checked for coupons. Within 15-minutes I found a "Summer Road Trip Check-up" special for only \$14.95 which included a 23-point safety checklist.

I dropped my car off and went for a walk. When I returned they provided several suggested service items, all of which were not necessary except for the tires. They said the front two were bald and the back two weren't much better, suggesting a tire shop on the other side of town. The cost of four new tires was way more than I had to spend, but I trusted the Lord would figure it out. I went back online to look for more coupons and make calls to see what my options were.

After 30-minutes of contacting various tire stores in the area, the lowest price I could find was still more than I could afford. I decided to call up the Consultant I do work for to clarify the date of my next paycheck in order to juggle money accordingly. After sharing my tire dilemma, he suggested purchasing quality used tires and also checking a different part of metro-Atlanta since the area I was currently staying tended to be overpriced.

I googled used tire shops in another part of metro-Atlanta, made a few calls, and the only one who answered the phone gave me a deal I couldn't pass up. I arranged to stop by first thing the next morning. As I went to bed, I reminded the Lord that I trusted Him - even though I saw no realistic way to pay for both my upcoming bills and the tires and asked Him to miraculously provide a way to make it all happen.

I arrived at the tire store early and hung out until they opened. After the mechanic arrived and I told him what I needed, he walked over to my car, took one look at my tires and with righteous anger said, "These tires don't need to be replaced....who told you that? Look at your treads, do they look bald to you?" I responded sheepishly because I've never been able to clearly tell bald from good tire treads. He looked me straight in the eye and said he was not going to take my money for something I didn't need, unlike other shops who would take it just to make a buck.

I thanked the mechanic profusely, told him the Lord would bless his integrity, and asked him to rotate the tires since I knew they needed at least that much done. After I paid for the rotation, I handed him a \$5 bill to buy a coffee or beer on me (I wished I had a larger bill in my wallet, because I would've gladly given him more to reward his honesty!).

My prayers were answered! Jehovah Jireh had definitely gone before me to lead me to the right mechanic in order to provide a miraculous turnaround as His testimony of continual provision in exchange for my heart and my will surrendered to Him.

Did the Lord fix my tires overnight as I lay sleeping or did the first mechanic just make a mistake? Who cares!! All I know is the Lord took care of it, and He can do that anyway He pleases! As I drove away from the tire shop you better believe the heavens heard me praising the Lord in a mighty way! :)

Whenever I surrender my finances and my future to the Lord, it gives Him the opportunity to bless me in ways I can't even imagine (Eph 3:20) and I know the blessings will keep coming as long as I step out in faith each day from this point forward!

My car is now ready for the trip. All I have left to do is take the stuff I don't need to the storage unit. Based on what happened today with the car, I know it's going to be an amazing Adventure!

Chapter 3 - You Shall Have No Idols

<u>July 12</u>

A few weeks ago, before I had made the decision to go on the Adventure with the Lord, one of my big hesitations in saying yes was the inconvenience of having to live out of my car and sleep in a different place night after night.

The Lord loves me too much to allow me to stay in a mindset that isn't serving me well, so it didn't take too long for Him to convict me of my "comfort and convenience" idol. Idol may be an odd word to use, but if you think about it, <u>anything</u> we value more than the Lord and <u>anything</u> that prevents us from following the Lord's will for our lives is essentially a modern-day idol. Even our feelings can be idols if they get in the way.

Here's how that conviction happened: For days I had been wrestling with the Lord, trying to wrap my head around His "crazy" road trip request and really hoping I had totally misheard His invitation. After all, the Lord knows I rarely ever sleep through the night because I'm such a light sleeper...especially when I'm on a couch out in the open rather than in a spare bedroom with the illusion of being in my own space.

Just thinking about having to spend an unknown number of weeks or months bouncing from couch to couch, or potentially sleeping in my car from time to time, was not appealing to me. Not only that, with my unstable financial situation how would I pay for meals and gas on the trip?

A day or so later as I was going through emails, a video from Bethel Church in CA caught my eye. It was titled, "Shifting Spiritual Atmospheres" with Dawna DeSilva. The moment I saw it I knew the Lord wanted me to watch the video. It was chock full of fantastic information. Then right near the end, the Lord lovingly sucker-punched me. I don't exactly remember what Dawna said, but the message was basically this (in my words): "What are you holding tightly to in your life that could be an obstacle to what the Lord wants for your life?"

Man!!!! The Lord knows how to accurately shoot a truth arrow straight into my heart!

That moment was probably the first time I knew this trip was going to happen, even though I wasn't ready to accept it just yet. As that question resonated within my heart and soul, my eyes started tearing. I immediately repented at valuing comfort and convenience more than the Lord's will for my life. I quickly asked Him to forgive me, and requested His help to lay those desires down as I considered accepting his Adventure invitation. It took a few days to process through my feelings before peace around the trip showed up more consistently.

Fast-forward to now and my attitude is completely different. It's been so much fun sharing my upcoming Adventure with friends and family, and making plans to "couch surf" as I travel throughout the country. One of the best planning conversations I had via text was with Becca, one of my New York Youth For Christ (YFC) kids from back in 1987. I unofficially adopted her and her brother, Ray, at the same time their Mom adopted me as a member of their family when I was running a YFC club at their home.

I was 20 at the time, Becca was 13 and I think Ray was 12. The first memory they have of me is setting up a flag football game with all the YFC kids and playfully running Ray over to get to the goal line (or at least that's how I remember it). Ray couldn't believe a girl beat him and I just laughed because most people have always underestimated my determination and inner strength to accomplish whatever I set out to do. Ray, Becca and I became fast friends and "family" that day. We've stayed in touch all these years, just like I've stayed in touch with my Indiana YFC kids when I worked there in 1990.

The reason my conversation with Becca was so amazing was because the Lord used her to remind me, once again, He goes before me to prepare my way. I totally forgot she started a non-profit years ago called "Dirty Kid Couch-surfing Coalition" to assist homeless and transient youth in finding shelter, transportation and friendship as they travel across the U.S. Becca told me she had connections all across the country and said to let her know if I needed a place to stay so she could check her database for a reputable host who would consider taking me in for a night even though I'm not homeless.

How cool is that? Thirty-years ago I was taking care of her and now she's taking care of me! I love how the Lord arranges things like that to bless me. As I've contacted all my YFC "kids" about my Adventure travel plans, they can't wait to see me and have all offered their homes to hang out for a few days as I pass through their areas.

I have a few other planned stops with people I know, but most of my trip is uncertain. I have no idea where I'll be staying or what situations I may run into. Yet, I trust the Lord will provide a safe place every night regardless of whether it's on a couch, in a spare room, or even in my car. Not to mention, as I find Celebrate Recovery meetings along my route who have openings for testimony speakers, my hope is that they will consider hosting me for a night along my travels.

One thing I am certain of is the Lord would never have invited me on this "crazy" Adventure if He wasn't setting me up for something amazing in the next season of my life. When the Lord calls someone into a higher position of authority and responsibility in His kingdom, the preparation challenges are generally more difficult than normal to ensure they learn what they need to learn in order to succeed.

I know my Adventure journey is an equipping and sanctification period for the spiritual mantles He's going to give me and the new anointing that's coming. This entire trip seems to be designed to deepen my faith and develop a deeper intimacy with Him.

I anticipate the trip won't always be smooth and am guessing the Lord is going to allow the enemy to set up some difficult challenges for me along the way to refine my character and give me opportunities to use the spiritual gifts and natural skills I've developed throughout my life for His glory and my growth. Though I'm not really looking forward to those moments, I know the Lord will always provide a way through it (Philippians 4:19 / Psalm 115:11-12), and I'll be better for it when I get to the other side.

Chapter 15 - Radical Obedience

When I left Indiana and began heading West towards Washington, it was at that moment I truly began the "radical obedience" part of my Adventure. Up until that point I had been on familiar ground because no matter where I had traveled previously, Atlanta could be reached within 1000 miles from any direction. I also had family and friends scattered throughout the area. Essentially, I was in a "safe" zone which was why I knew I was struggling with the decision to go West or South after I finished my Indiana visit.

Leaving for the Adventure in July was a step into radical obedience, but for some reason it felt even more radical to drive out of my safety zone and head 2000 more miles across the country without knowing a soul in between Indiana and the coast of Washington.

Before I committed to heading West, I spent a lot of time reflecting on everything that had happened during the Adventure and all the moments where the Lord had showed up and showed off. My mind was still astonished at all the divine moments of provision and connections which had occurred in the last 30 days. The Adventure had been a series of blind faith decisions along with annoying challenges, and yet I didn't regret any of it. It was as if my life had become a movie in motion and I was in the audience with everyone else wondering what would happen next.

I processed through all my concerns about the next 2000 miles, followed by the 5000 miles that would follow to return to Atlanta. In my mind I had two scales: the "what if" scale of all the things that could go wrong and the "regret" scale of what I would miss if I didn't take the leap of faith and just go forward. Regret always weighs heavier on my mind than any potential problems that could occur, which ultimately made it easier to make a decision.

As I continue to write this book, I am so thankful I did say YES to the Lord, and you'll see why as you read through the rest of the blog entries which are full of incredible G-d stories and lots of lessons I learned along the way.

There is no such thing as a boring life when you choose radical obedience. The experience of living that type of life is abundantly more valuable than you can imagine. All that's required is a "yes" and "amen" (2 Corinthians 1:20) to receive the promises that come from choosing to be radically obedient to the Lord's will for your life.

Earlier in the chapter titled "Acts Is A Lifestyle & Mindset," I stated that we were never meant to live normal lives. Normal is a world standard. G-d's standard is very different. The Lord is in the business of Kingdom impact to bring as many people into the family of Believers before Jesus returns to the Earth to bring us all home (Revelation 19).

Kingdom impact doesn't just happen. The Lord wants us to partner with Him in His work on Earth. The Bible is full of stories where the Lord asks a variety of men and women to partner with Him to achieve His desired outcome. Each one of those men and women opted for radical obedience to the Lord regardless of the pain and suffering they could experience along the way.

Examples include:

- 1. *Mary, the mother of Jesus*: She could've chosen to say "no" when the angel asked her to allow the Holy Spirit to impregnate her outside of marriage; especially because she knew she could be rightfully kicked out of her family or killed because of it. Mary must've sensed a profound destiny in the request. Luke's gospel portrays her feelings in Luke 1:46-55 when Mary erupted into praise after arriving at Elizabeth's home (her cousin) who was also pregnant with John the Baptist.
- 2. *Abraham*: When the Lord asked Abraham to leave everything he knew behind to head towards an uncertain land, he could have stayed where he was and lived in wealth until he died. He chose to walk forward in faith, and now he is recognized by every Jew and Christian as the standard for faithfulness.
- 3. Joshua: The first mention of Joshua is in Exodus 17:9 when Moses tells him to lead the Israelites into battle with Amalek army. After that, every decision Joshua made was based upon the Lord's vow to deliver the promised land to his people. Also, when Moses asked Joshua to be his assistant, Joshua could've avoided that responsibility and simply maintained the same type of life everyone else had while traveling the desert. His obedience was absolute both to Moses and the Lord, until finally he was named as Moses' successor upon his death.
- 4. Esther. After she became Queen to a Persian King and settled into her role, her Uncle asked her to use her influence to save the Jewish people from a plot to destroy their race. In the Persian culture the King could execute anyone who approached him without permission, and Esther knew that. She had a choice to make: ignore the plight of her people or consider that the Lord put her in that position "for such a time as this" (Esther 4:14). Because of her radical obedience, not only were the Jews saved, but her Uncle was elevated into a higher position of authority within the Persian Kingdom.
- 5. David: It took almost 15 years from the time he was anointed as King while Saul still reigned to the time he took the throne himself. During most of it, he was on the run for his life, had to live in caves, and experienced many other difficulties. At any point he could've walked away from his destiny, but he didn't which is why David is listed in the faith hall of fame (Hebrews 11:32) and considered a man after G-d's own heart (1 Samuel 13:14).
- 6. *The Disciples* Before Jesus approached each of the disciples to follow him, most them had typical family responsibilities and some sort of vocation to make a living. Each one chose Jesus over their cultural expectations based on many generations before. By all appearances, it was crazy to give up everything and follow a man they hardly knew. And yet all of them, except Judas, went to their death praising the Messiah rather than denying who He was to save their lives.

7. Saul/Paul: He was an extremely respected Pharisee and Jewish leader who rigidly upheld the law. The first mention of him in the Bible is Acts 7:58 during the stoning of Stephen: "Then they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their garments at the feet of a young man named Saul." After a transformational encounter with Jesus in Acts 9, the Lord commissioned Saul to bring the Gospel message to the Gentiles. Saul then adopts the Greek name Paul and becomes the largest contributor of authorized scripture in the New Testament. Paul's life was not easy in the least, and he could've walked away in frustration and exhaustion many times. Yet throughout his Epistles he describes over and over how proud he is to have sacrificed the life he could have had for a life sold out to the Lord.

It's hard to imagine walking in the shoes of the people I just mentioned because it's basic human nature to avoid pain and suffering under any circumstance. We also love to cling to as much control of our world as possible. Choosing radical obedience means we must give up all control to the Lord and be willing to suffer - even unjustly - should the Lord allow it to happen. No one willingly does that unless they have a deep level of trust in the person asking them to make that choice.

You cannot develop that level of faith in someone unless you've been through enough "foxhole" circumstances to have it tested and consistently proven true. That's what happened to me over the last 10 years. I had numerous "foxhole" circumstances in my life where I was forced to depend only upon the Lord to get me through them.

Even though a long season of brokenness caused me to lose faith in the Lord for a short while, the "comeback" foxhole circumstance was the turning point to increase my faith to a level I had never experienced before...despite the Lord not fixing my situation. That new level of trust that appeared became a stepping stone towards the radical obedience I needed to say yes to the Lord's invitation to go on this crazy Adventure.

Looking back, I can't imagine what my life would be like today if I had not experienced every moment of that "crazy" journey. My life is enriched because of it and it has laid a solid foundation for whatever the Lord has for me next.

A "normal" life is not even remotely acceptable for me anymore. I've seen too much, and my expectations of the Lord are much higher than ever because I know that freedom in Christ means living my life full-out for the Lord however He asks, and whatever that means - even when it makes no sense to the people who love me most. It's much more important for me to be obedient to the Lord than to receive approve from anyone around me.

You have the same Holy Spirit inside you that Jesus had access to. This passage originally recorded in Isaiah 61 was used by Jesus in Luke 4:18-19 as a proclamation of His position as Messiah; and I believe it can also become a proclamation for us today to fully embrace His Spirit as His Disciples on the Earth: "*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to*

proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor" (ESV).

Take a moment and think about what your life could look like if you spent time in prayer seeking the Lord's will for your life in this season, and then committed to being radically obedient to whatever He asks of you.

For some of you, it's no mystery what the Lord wants. You have just been too afraid or selfish to say yes. For others, your heart is in the right place, but you have no clue what that could look like for you and your family.

Here's what I know: the Lord will never invite you into something He isn't willing to prepare you to do through Him; and if you are married or have a family, He will always provide a way for all of you to walk out His assignment together, individually and as a family. All it requires is a leap of faith, yes and amen!

If you are ready to take a leap of faith and step into radical obedience with the Lord, take a moment and say the prayer below. If you are not yet ready, but want to be, say the 2nd prayer. And if you are not even near wanting to be ready, skip the rest of this chapter and move onto the next chapter.

No judgement! I promise! It's a process to desire that level of radical obedience, never mind choose it! Take a deep breath and just flip to the next chapter. The Lord sees your heart and I promise He has more than enough grace and mercy to wait until you are ready for that depth of relationship with Him.

Radical Obedience Readiness Prayer:

Lord Jesus, I am ready to be radically obedient to your will for my life. I know the plans you have for me are good and you always honor those who honor you. If you have already shown me what you want from me and I missed it, please send me another message and help me to clearly recognize it. If I recognized the message when you sent it, but avoided taking the next step, I repent and will bravely move forward in some way as evidence of my commitment to be radically obedient to you.

Thank you in advance, Lord, for the provision you are setting up to support the path you have asked me to travel. Thank you also for the people you will put in my way to guide me as I move forward.


I am ready to live an extraordinary life through radical obedience and trust any suffering I may experience (through another person's free will or divinely allowed in order to prune my character) will not be wasted. I trust it will serve to make me stronger over time. I love you, Lord, and fully surrender my will to you however that looks.

Desire for Radical Obedience Prayer

Lord, my heart wants to say "yes and amen" to a life of radical obedience, but I don't yet have the courage to do so. I know with you all things are possible. Therefore, I ask for an increase of courage to take the next step towards living a radically obedient life with you. I give you permission to develop that courage in me through whatever circumstances you see fit. Thank you, Lord, for honoring my prayer.

Coaching and Training are often used interchangeably, but they are different styles of development. In a nutshell, training is more about transferring knowledge while coaching is about enhancing knowledge.

Training is driven by the trainer who generally controls the process and is satisfied with providing knowledge and building skills. Coaching, on the other hand, is a facilitated conversation where the coach and client partner to create an environment and a flexible structure to achieve desired professional or personal results.

Coaching does this through helping a person focus their energies effectively; encourages the full utilization of strengths; identifies weaknesses and transforms them into strengths; applies feedback and review of key challenges; and reinforces the behaviors that serve you well to continue progress toward your short and long-term goals.

The best fictional analogy I can think of for a coach/client relationship is Frodo Baggins and Samwise Gamgee from *The Lord of the Rings*. Frodo felt compelled to destroy the One Ring in the fires of Mount Doom in Mordor, but had no idea how to go about it because it was a mammoth task with no clear plan of action. Frodo knew he couldn't do it alone, so he asked Sam to join him. Sam didn't tell Frodo how to begin his journey or what steps he needed to take. He simply waited for Frodo to make up his mind and followed him onward. During the journey Sam helped Frodo determine the results he wanted, provided insight, asked him questions when he was curious or felt something wasn't quite right, assisted in creating action plans, encouraged him, and held him accountable for his goal, no matter how agitated Frodo got with him along the way.

Sam also helped Frodo see alternatives he hadn't considered, and his mere presence became Frodo's strength when Frodo became too weary and wanted to give up. Overall Sam was the rock (and catalyst) that Frodo needed to achieve his goal. Without Sam, Frodo may never have reached Mount Doom.

One of my main responsibilities as your Coach is to hold you accountable to your goals and "hold your hand" through the change process when forward movement becomes very difficult. I always tell my clients before they start their coaching program: "*The change process will often be difficult and may bring periods of intense joy or intense discomfort. As you are experiencing the forward movement of change, celebrate whichever period you are in because it means you are getting much closer to where you desire to be in your personal or professional life.*"


